Dressage tests – 1B, 2B, 3B, 4B 5B (PCAV Tests Nov.2006) - 60 x 20 m arenas for grade 1 - 3
Horse Trials and Showjumping: maximum heights and spreads at max height in metres:-

Grades	1	2	3	4	5
Max Height	1.05	0.90	0.75	0.60	0.45
Max Spread	1.20	0.90	0.65	0.50	0.45

Conditions of Entry: Entry is conditional upon acceptance of these conditions.

1. Entry Fee: Pony Club \$25 Non PCAV \$35
2. Before riding:
 - a. all open competitors must sign a day attendance form; and if a current pony club card cannot be presented, pay an additional \$5.00
 - b. PCAV club member cards must be inspected at the secretary's office.
3. No refunds after closing date except with vet or medical certificate. An admin fee of \$10 will be deducted.
4. Entering this competition constitutes acknowledgement that PCAV rules apply and acceptance of these rules.
5. The organising committee reserves the right to cancel any class or competition; divide any class; alter times; refuse any entry with or without stating the reason.
6. Competitors may ride more than one horse, subject to the conditions of PCAV *Handbook of By-laws* multiple horse rules.
7. Complying helmets must worn, spot checks may occur.
8. Gear Check: required for all riders before each phase.
9. Armbands: must be worn by all competitors.
10. Riders under eight years of age may not compete, horses must be at least age four, no stallions, colts or rigs.
11. Competitor numbers - the organising committee will pre-allocate and advise numbers. Competitors may supply their own numbers. However, body numbers must be used. Body numbers will be available at the event.
12. PCAV Alcohol Policy applies.
13. Dogs are prohibited without exception.
14. Queries, protests, horse abuse, rules as per the PCAV *Handbook of By-Laws*.
15. Neither the organising committee of this competition nor the PCAV accepts any responsibility whatsoever for any accident, damage, injury or illness to horses, riders, ground spectators or any other person or property.
16. Horses must only be lunged in the area designated for lunging.
17. Equal placings will not be given. Dressage: the higher total collective marks will decide the higher placing. Cross-Country time closest to the allowed time without time penalties (this means only riders who come in at or under the allowed time).
